



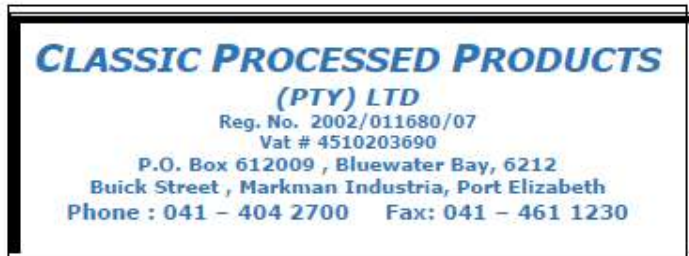

MJC PORK DEBACLE

The following letter issued by *Classic Processed Products*, more than adequately portrays the haraam PORK-VARK shenanigans of the MJC.

Dear CUSTOMERS

NOTICE OF TRANSITION TO "NON-HALAAL MEAT" STATUS BY 31 JULY 2020

I wish to inform all customers that after consideration of various cost drivers and after consultation with numerous clients, Classic has decided to end the Halaal status of our meat products in the future.

The Classic facility will keep its Halaal status until 31 July 2020 and will continue to produce Halaal MEAT products until such time as all packaging marked with the MJC Halaal Logo has been used and until the product has been sold out of the trade. However we have begun the process of removing the MJC logo from all new printed packaging, which means that you will soon find some products arriving in store without a Halaal logo on the packaging.

To summarise:

1. Classic remains a MJC Halaal certified facility, however we will voluntarily change to a NON-HALAAL status after 31 July 2020.
2. Classic will therefore start producing product without the MJC logo moving forward.
3. Our products will remain "NO PORK" products until further notice.
4. Any product showing a MJC Halaal logo is still guaranteed to be Halaal, but products without the logo are not guaranteed Halaal after 31 July 2020.
5. To allow time for consumers to get used to not seeing the Halaal logo, we suggest
 - a. that all meat products from Classic should be treated as non-Halaal moving forward and
 - b. your stores must move our meat products out of any designated Halaal area. i.e. the product should be displayed in cabinets with other non-Halaal products.
6. This will apply to all processed meat brands produced by Classic Processed Products.
7. This change will not impact our food safety status in any way.

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We regret any inconvenience caused, however we believe this to be in the best interest of keeping our products both affordable and competitive for our consumers moving forward.
